The consultant will be responsible for facilitating the development of this strategic document for the Ministry of Health.

MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conduct literature review for examples of multi-hazard preparedness and response plans
- Assess results from the March 2021 mapping of health risks in Burkina Faso
- Propose a draft zero health emergency preparedness and response plan based on existing plans and WHO development guidelines
- Communicate regularly with the CORUS focal point in charge of the issue
- Facilitate the work of developing the plan.
- Finalize the multi-hazard health emergency preparedness and response plan document
- Perform other duties as assigned that are directly related to this work.
